

COMMUNION SERVERS VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITIES

North Site Services

1. Arrive 10-15 minutes prior to the service.
2. Check in with the Worship Assistant.
3. At the conclusion of the Lord's Prayer, go forward to the altar via the center aisle. You will be served communion first.
4. Most often you will serve the wine. Say, "**The blood of Christ shed for you**" as communicants either dip the bread/wafer or take a cup.
5. If serving bread, say "**The body of Christ given for you**".
6. To bless those who don't commune, place your hand on the head of the one being blessed. *The hand giving the blessing shouldn't be the one you are using to distribute the bread, you will need to switch hands.* "**The blessing of God is yours today and always**" or another suitable blessing should be offered.
7. Due to special dietary needs or allergies, some members do provide their own bread/wafer.
8. After all have communed, return the elements to the altar.
9. Return to your seat via the center aisle.
